They are lightweight, simple to use and save both the amputee and prosthetist time and hassle associated with cleaning components. The PRO ARMOUR® Lite also gives amputees the confidence and freedom to do more, without worrying about foreign objects damaging expensive prosthetic components. Full range of pediatric and adult sizing available.

Transitioning in wet areas can now be done with ease whether this is at the beach, in the bathroom, poolside, or on wooden and lino flooring.

Being lightweight and simple to use, the PRO ARMOUR® PLUS gives amputees the confidence and freedom to do more without worrying about foreign objects damaging expensive prosthetic components.
